**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Harley Brown shall appear before this Honorable Court on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of Sept., 2006, at 10 (a.m.) p.m. to show cause why this Court should not hold Mr. Brown in contempt for disobeying the Court's April 10, 2006 Corrected Liquidation Order.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, pursuant to MCR 2.107(B)(1)(b), service upon Harley Brown may and shall be accomplished by sending a copy of this Order and the Motion to Harley Brown via certified mail at: (a) 2401 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Detroit, Michigan 48216, the Registered Office Address of several Michigan corporations for which Mr. Brown is designated as Resident Agent; and (b) 18221 Hamilton Road, Highland Park, Michigan 48203, which upon information and belief (based upon Mr. Brown's 2005 income tax returns and searches of online information databases) is Mr. Brown's current residence address. The Order and Motion shall be so served upon Harley Brown at least five (5) days before the date and time fixed for showing cause, and proof of such service shall be made to the Court.
