**MEMORANDUM**

**TO:** State Board of Education

**FROM:** Michael P. Flanagan, Chairman 

**SUBJECT:** Approval of Nominations to the Special Education Advisory Committee

The Special Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) advises the State Board of Education on matters concerning the education of children with disabilities. The Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act, as amended in 2004, requires that this advisory committee include a 51% representation of person with, or parents of children with, disabilities (ages birth through 26).

In May 2005, the Board approved nominations to the SEAC. Two Member-at-Large seats were filled in October 2005. On September 29, 2005, Public Act 137 took effect, allowing four organizations that previously shared two seats to each have a seat. Attachment A identifies four individuals to fill these vacancies and four individuals to serve as alternates. Their biographical resumes are included in Attachment B.

It is recommended that the State Board of Education approve the nominees listed in Attachment A of the Superintendent's memorandum of December 5, 2005, and appoint those individuals to serve as members of the Special Education Advisory Committee for the respective terms specified.
