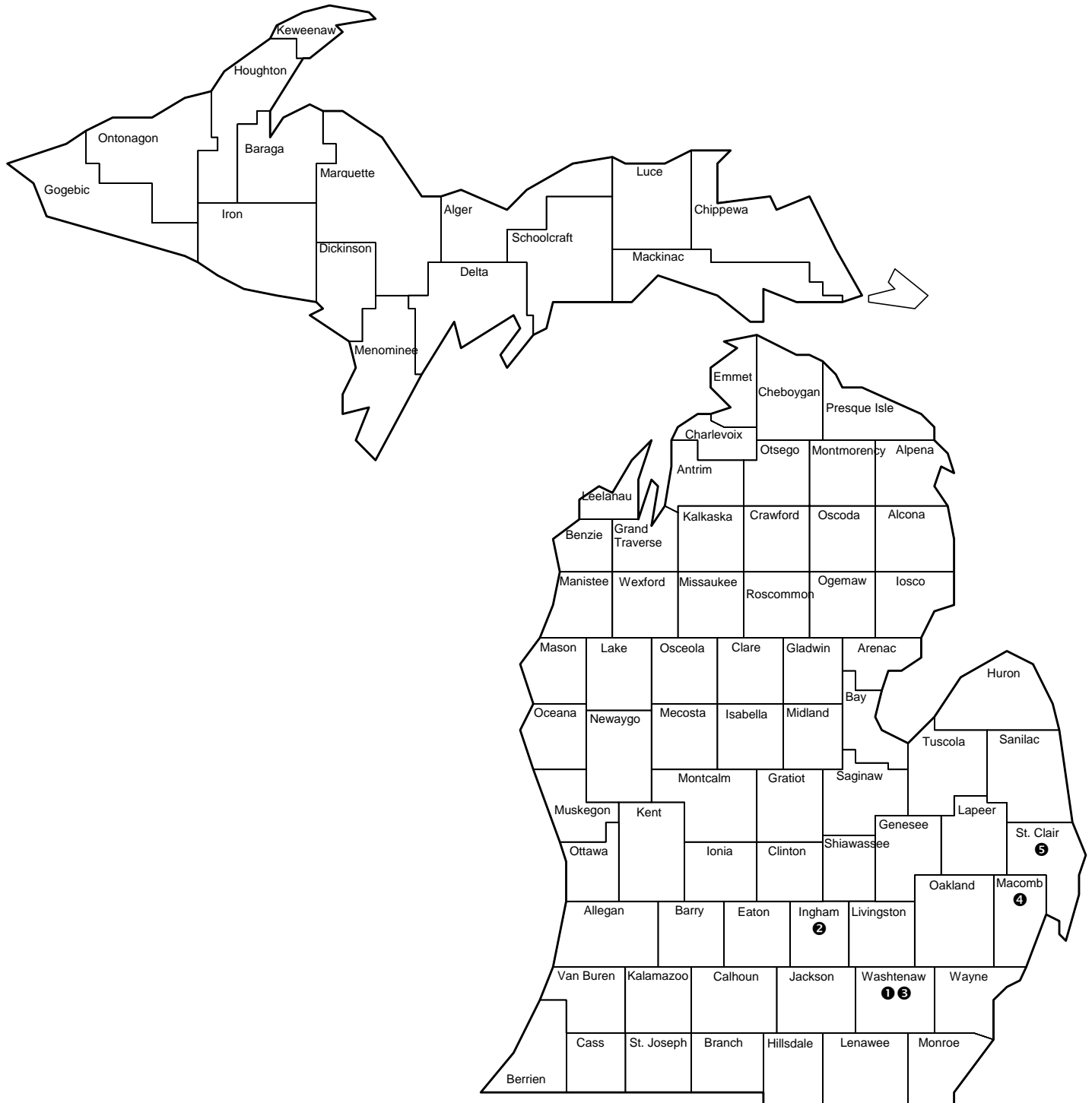

PUBLIC MEETING ON A PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN (RAP) FOR THE SOUTHEAST BERRIEN COUNTY LANDFILL, 3200 CHAMBERLAIN ROAD, BERRIEN COUNTY. The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality will hold a public meeting on a proposed RAP for the Southeast

Southeast Berrien County Landfill, a site of environmental contamination located in Bertrand Township. The meeting location is at the Niles Inn and Conference Center; 930 11th Street, Niles Michigan 49120. The hearing record will remain open to receive written comments until 5:00 PM on October 21, 2009. The origin of the contamination is a Type II municipal solid waste landfill. A plume of Iron and Manganese contaminated groundwater proceeds northwesterly from the landfill. The remediation option includes pumping and treating the contaminated groundwater along the landfill's north and west property lines, and the monitoring of groundwater at sentinel wells northwest of the landfill. In addition, deed restrictions and notices of aesthetic impact on affected properties located downgradient of the landfill will protect property owners from exposure to aesthetic impacts from the local groundwater. Should groundwater contaminated by the landfill reach the sentinel wells, an alternate treatment system will be implemented to assure that water contaminated by the landfill does not reach properties that do not include deed restrictions or notices of aesthetic impact.
