The Department of Energy, Labor and Economic Growth, Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 2, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. at the Michigan Library and Historical Center, 702 West Kalamazoo, Lansing, Michigan in the Forum on the Ground Floor. This is a second public hearing on revised rules to add proposed R 500.2231 and R 500.2232 to the Michigan Administrative Code. The hearing will be held to receive public comments on proposed revised rules to prohibit the use in insurance policy forms of certain specifically identified clauses that do not conform to the requirements of the Insurance Code.

These rules are promulgated by authority conferred on the commissioner of the Office of Financial and Insurance Regulation by Sections 210, 2236, and 3525 of the Insurance Code, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.210, MCL 500.2236, and MCL 500.3525. These rules are proposed to take effect 7 days after filing with the Secretary of State.
