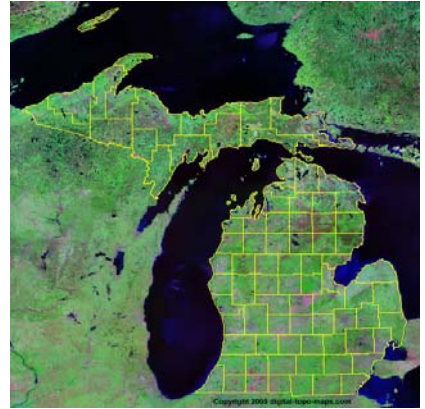


# More on the MI BEI...
