2. **REQUEST FOR RULEMAKING/ENERGY CODE UPDATE PLAN**

Mr. Green discussed the letter sent to the committee members that provided them with background on the work ahead of the Committee and enclosures for use during the meetings.

Mr. Green reviewed the Request for Rulemaking for Residential Part 10 and Commercial Part 10a with the Committee. He then reviewed the Energy Code Update Plan, which outlines the Background, Evaluation Process including the Committee Structure, Submission Process, Review Process, and Consideration by Director. Mr. Green noted that we will be using the 2008 RS Means rather than the 2007 version.

Mr. Green asked Todd Cordill to review an example of the Energy10® Software.

3. **DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS**

Each of the committee members were provided the following documents:

- ASHRAE Standard, International Energy Conservation Code
- Residential Matrix with the current Residential Part 10 Rules
- Commercial Matrix with the Current Commercial Part 10a Rules

Mr. Green reviewed the Commercial and the Residential Matrix. He gave an overview of the process for making changes to the proposed revision offered by staff by using the track change feature in Micro Soft Word.

Mr. Green asked the Committee to review the Commercial requirements and the Residential Matrix pages 1-5 for discussion at the next meeting.

Some discussion was raised regarding controversy and the previous attempt to promulgate an Energy Code. The 3 sticking points that will require the most discussion will be the default table, fenestration requirements, and existing buildings.
