NUMBER OF FISHING RODS ON MICHIGAN WATERS

By authority conferred on the Department of Natural Resources by section 48703 of 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.48703, it is ordered that effective, November 6, 2008, for a period of five years, the following regulations are established for the number of fishing rods on Michigan waters:

On all of the public waters of Michigan, those persons in the act of fishing shall be restricted to using no more than 3 single lines or 3 single rods and lines, and shall not attach more than six hooks total on all lines.

This order shall be assigned number FO-247.09 and is entitled "Number of Fishing Rods on Michigan Waters."

This order rescinds the order entitled "Number of Fishing Rods on the Great Lakes and Connecting Waters" effective September 29, 2000, and assigned number FO-207.00.

This order shall take effect on April 1, 2009, and shall remain effective through March 31, 2014.
