

**LIBRARY OF MICHIGAN  
SCHOOL LIBRARY WORKGROUP**

- CHARGE:** To meet with Library of Michigan staff to discuss issues facing Michigan school libraries, the resources available from the Library of Michigan, and to occasionally review the Michigan School Libraries for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century program measures.

- TERMS:** 2 years or 3 years, depending on availability.  
A member can serve up to two terms
- SCHEDULE:** Two meetings a year, as needed. Both meetings are held in the summer on dates acceptable to the majority of the group.
- MEETINGS:** Meetings will be held at the Library of Michigan and virtually. The meeting agendas will be discussed and decided on as a group before the meetings are held.
- MEMBERSHIP:** Membership will include Library of Michigan staff, Michigan Association of School Librarians (MASL) current leadership as well as school librarians from around the state. When possible, the Library of Michigan will attempt to be diverse in the membership. Members will be solicited from schools serving communities that represent a range of geographic areas, socio-economic groups, and population sizes. Maximum membership is ten, excluding Library of Michigan staff and MASL leadership.
