Product should be returned to the place of purchase. Dealers should return unsold inventory and products returned by customers to their distributor.

Problem/Reason for Recall:

These products may be contaminated with *Salmonella*. People handling these pet foods can become infected with *Salmonella*, especially if they have not thoroughly washed their hands after having contact with any of these pet foods or any surfaces exposed to these products.

Salmonella can cause serious illness in small children, frail or elderly people, and people and pets with weakened immune systems. Other people and pets may suffer short-term symptoms, such as high fever, severe headache, vomiting, nausea, abdominal pain, and diarrhea. Long term complications can include arthritis.
