

Michigan Quarantines & Regulations Applicable to Incoming Nursery Stock

Nursery stock growers and dealers are advised to keep updated on quarantines and regulations as applicable to specific types of nursery stock brought into the state from outside of Michigan. The following table summarizes Michigan quarantines and regulations relating to nursery stock.

| White Pine Blister Rust | Currant and gooseberry (<i>Ribes</i> spp.) plants | All sources | Black currant prohibited statewide except under permit. Permit required for other <i>Ribes</i> species in WPBR control area. | MDARD Ribes Permit + NSIC*** | |
