ADDENDUM #1

OPTOMETRY CONTINUING EDUCATION REVIEW
February 18, 2009

APPROVED PROGRAMS

1. **LAKESIDE OPHTHALMOLOGY CENTER** – Updates on Ocular Disease 2009 held February 11, 2009 in Clinton Township, MI 48038 for two hours pain management.
RECOMMENDATION: TWO HOURS IN PAIN MANAGEMENT.
2. **COBURN-KLEINFELDT EYE CLINIC** – Surgical Symposium held March 22, 2009 in Birmingham, MI for eight hours, five of which are in clinical optometry, and three of which are in pharmaceutical management.
RECOMMENDATION: EIGHT HOURS WITH FIVE OF THOSE IN CLINICAL OPTOMETRY AND THREE IN PHARMACEUTICAL MANAGEMENT.
3. **MICHIGAN VISION THERAPY STUDY GROUP** – Vision & Learning held January 9, 2009 in Utica, MI for twelve hours in clinical optometry.
RECOMMENDATION: TWELVE HOURS IN CLINICAL OPTOMETRY.
4. **EYE SURGERY INSTITUTE** – Current Techniques in Cataract and Trabeculectomy held January 5, 2009 in Dearborn, MI for two hours in clinical optometry.
RECOMMENDATION: TWO HOURS IN CLINICAL OPTOMETRY.
5. **DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS MEDICAL CENTER** – Blind Rehabilitation: Advanced Low Vision Clinic held January 30, 2009 in Saginaw, MI for one hour in clinical optometry.
RECOMMENDATION: ONE HOUR IN CLINICAL OPTOMETRY.
6. **DR. LES I. SIEGEL, MD** –Surgical Procedures in Glaucoma & Cataracts held January, 1, 2009 in Southfield, MI for six to eight hours half of which were in pharmaceutical management and pain management.
RECOMMENDATION: SIX TO EIGHT HOURS WITH ONE TO TWO HOURS IN PHARMACEUTICAL MANAGEMENT.
7. **ANDERSEN EYE ASSOCIATES** – Grand Round held March 18, 2009 in Saginaw, MI for one hour in clinical optometry.
RECOMMENDATION: ONE HOUR IN CLINICAL OPTOMETRY.

8. **SHANBOM EYE SPECIALIST** – Technical Advancements in Ophthalmic Surgery V held January 27, 2009 in Bloomfield Hills, MI for six hours, three of which were in Clinical optometry, and three of which were in pharmaceutical management.
RECOMMENDATION: SIX HOURS WITH TWO HOURS IN PHARMACEUTICAL MANAGEMENT

9. **ASSOCIATED RETINAL CONSULTANTS, P.C.** – Management of Retinal Disease 2009 held April 18, 2009 in Grand Rapids, MI for four and one half hours, one and one half hours in clinical optometry and one and one half hours in pharmaceutical management.
RECOMMENDATION: FOUR AND ONE HALF HOURS, ONE AND ONE HALF OF WHICH IS IN PHARMACEUTICAL MANAGEMENT.
