Bach stated that more information needs to be provided to licensees to heighten awareness that a valid doctor/patient relationship must be established.

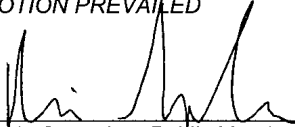

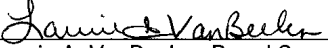
