MPJE Review Meeting Report

Schmidt and Collins attended the MPJE review meeting recently held. They reported that approximately 3,400 questions were reviewed with the focus being on eliminating K-type questions. Collins indicated that questions can be submitted when the next item workshop is held if any members wished to submit questions. On behalf of the Board, Bach thanked each of them for attending.

NABP District IV Meeting Report

Shaw reported that the State of Ohio provided a presentation on how they handle disciplinary cases in Ohio. Other topics of discussion included the increasing drug dependency amongst interns and technicians and dispensing errors. Both Shaw and Fakhoury commented that attendance was very beneficial. Shaw indicated that the NABP has updated its website to be more user-friendly. Fakhoury stated that a good discussion was also held regarding returning medications to stock. Shaw advised that the 2009 meeting will be held in southern Illinois.

Department Update

Ramsdell indicated that the procedure for criminal background checks applicable to all new licensees and individuals applying for re-licensure is going well. She stated that, on average, she is receiving reports within 24 hours of applicants being fingerprinted. Ramsdell also explained the "wrap-back" system in place which will enable the Department to be notified of a licensee's future criminal convictions.

Ramsdell also indicated that the Bureau has been given the duty of creating the rules and overseeing the registration process for the Medical Marihuana Program. She indicated that the proposed rules are available for review on the Department's website and the public hearing is scheduled for January 5, 2009.

The terms of the limitation include general supervision for six (6) months, and not less than 1,000 hours, which will run concurrent with probation, and quarterly employer reports shall be submitted to the Department. Additionally, Petitioner must ensure that his criminal background check is made available to the Department. Petitioner's license will be automatically reclassified upon successful completion of these terms.




