Lansing – The Advisory Council to the Michigan Department of Civil Rights (MDCR) Division on Deaf, DeafBlind and Hard of Hearing (DODDBHH) will meet on Friday, May 29, 2015 from 10 am to 3:00 pm at the Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center, 104 Conservation Drive, Roscommon 48653.

The meeting is open to the public. The agenda includes a discussion of the division's short- and long-term goals, and a legislative update.

Public comment periods are scheduled for approximately 11:30 am and 2:30 pm.
