

6 Review the Mean Scale Scores for Subgroups on the School Demographic Report

Now let's look at the mean score data from another perspective. You've reviewed the data for All Students. Now, let's look at your Mean Scale Scores for each subject area by subgroup on the **School Demographic Report** to see if you can get more "bang for your buck" by focusing on a specific subgroup.

1. The Demographic Report is sent with the MME test results, but if you cannot obtain a copy, go to the Bureau of Assessment and Accountability (BAA) Secure Site at <https://baa.state.mi.us/meap/login.asp>. Once you have logged in, click on **Student Test Scores** in the Reports section of the left menu. This is the same place that you access the School Summary Report.
