What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is investing approximately \$2.6 million to widen the roadway to three lanes between Kalamazoo River and Grant Street with curb and gutter and enclosed drainage, and repaving the roadway from Grant Street to Kalamazoo Street. This project includes sidewalk upgrades.

When Will This Be Done?

Work will begin in June and be completed by the end of October.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

M-89 traffic will be maintained with one lane in each direction utilizing traffic shifts. Short durations of flag control with one lane of alternating traffic will be utilized when necessary to construct the storm sewer. Access to all area businesses and residences will be maintained throughout the project.

Long-term Benefits

This project will reduce motorist delay by adding a center left-turn lane, reducing vehicle emissions and improving air quality. The repaving work will provide a smooth riding surface and will serve the motoring public for years to come.
