SUBJECT: Data export upload for e-Equalization online filing

Throughout this past year, the Assessment and Certification Division Staff has been working diligently to address any issues that were brought to our attention during the first year of our online filing process for State Equalization. One issue that was a concern was the inability to use the upload feature if you were not currently using BS&A software. We are happy to announce that the system is now able to accept imported data from those of you who have software other than BS&A, so long as the data is formatted properly. We have been successful in performing a test data upload to the online e-Equalization filing system from another software provider, and have updated our instructions to assist those who wish to take advantage of this new capability.

In order for data to be uploaded into the system from different software, it is necessary for your software to produce a data export file that is compatible with the requirements of the State system. If you are interested in taking advantage of this time saving process, please contact your software provider to see if they have already created the file format, or if they are willing to assist you with creating this export formatting. If your software provider has not already run a test file with our system, that would need to be done prior to your first attempt to upload. Please contact our office for assistance with this process. Once the export format is tested, you will be able to use the existing upload instructions within the program to do your own export uploads.

The file layout below is the exact layout necessary for the e-Equalization export to work. Please be aware that the fields and their EXACT widths are essential.
