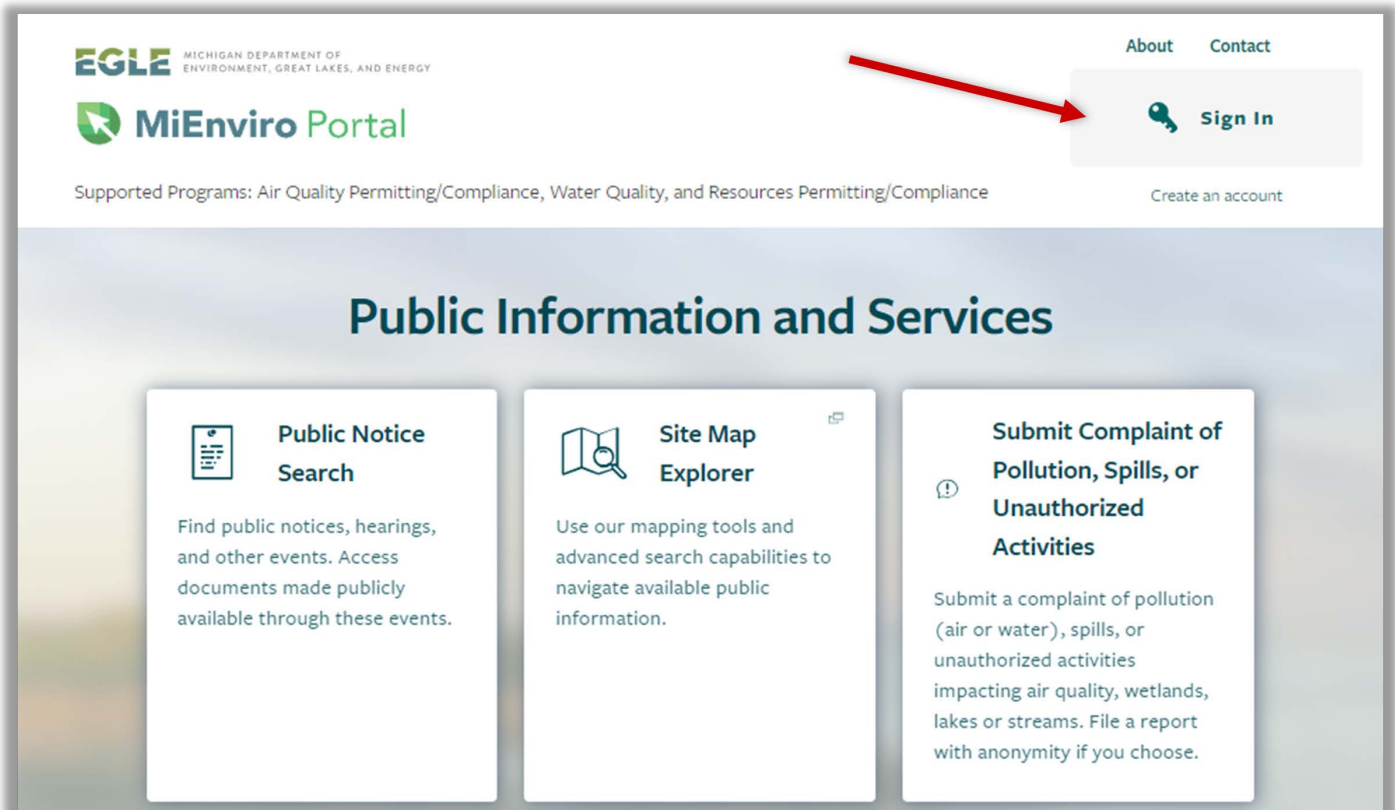
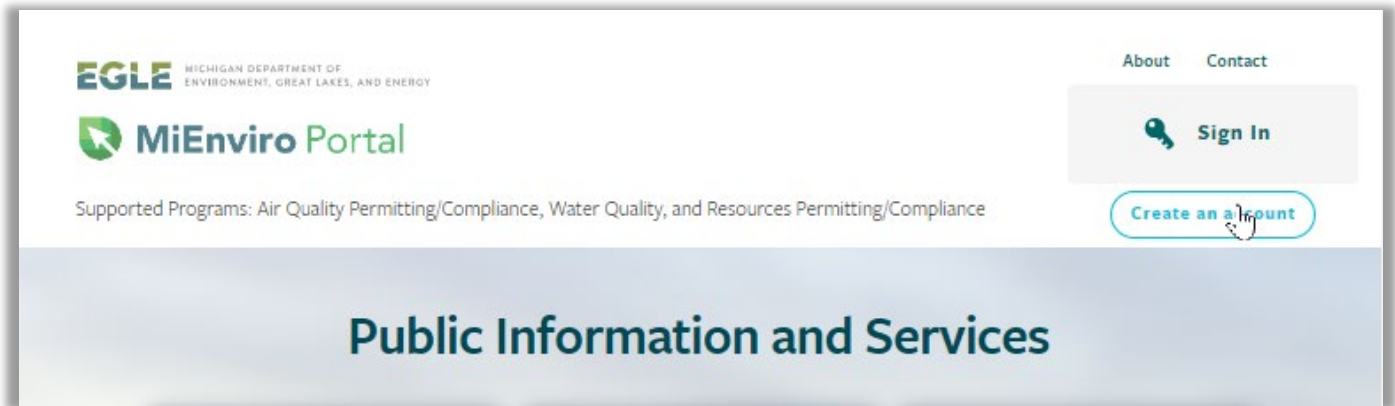
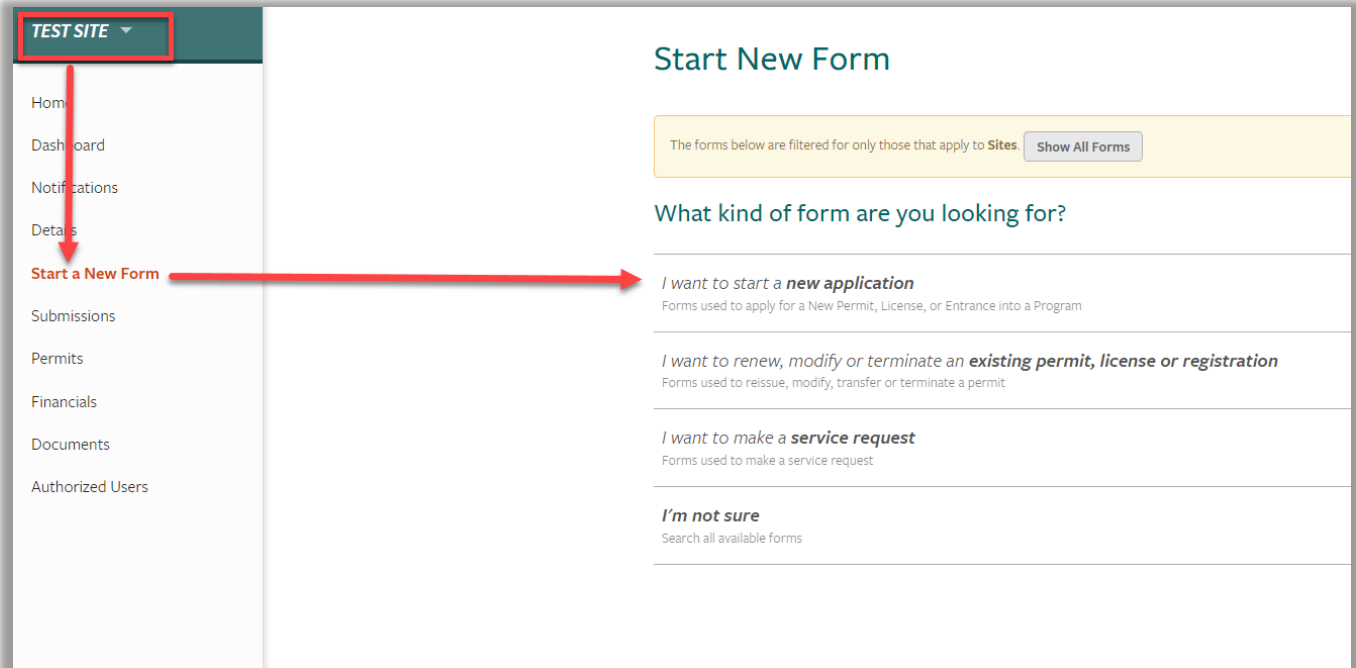


# Starting a New Joint Permit Application Submission in MiEnviro Portal

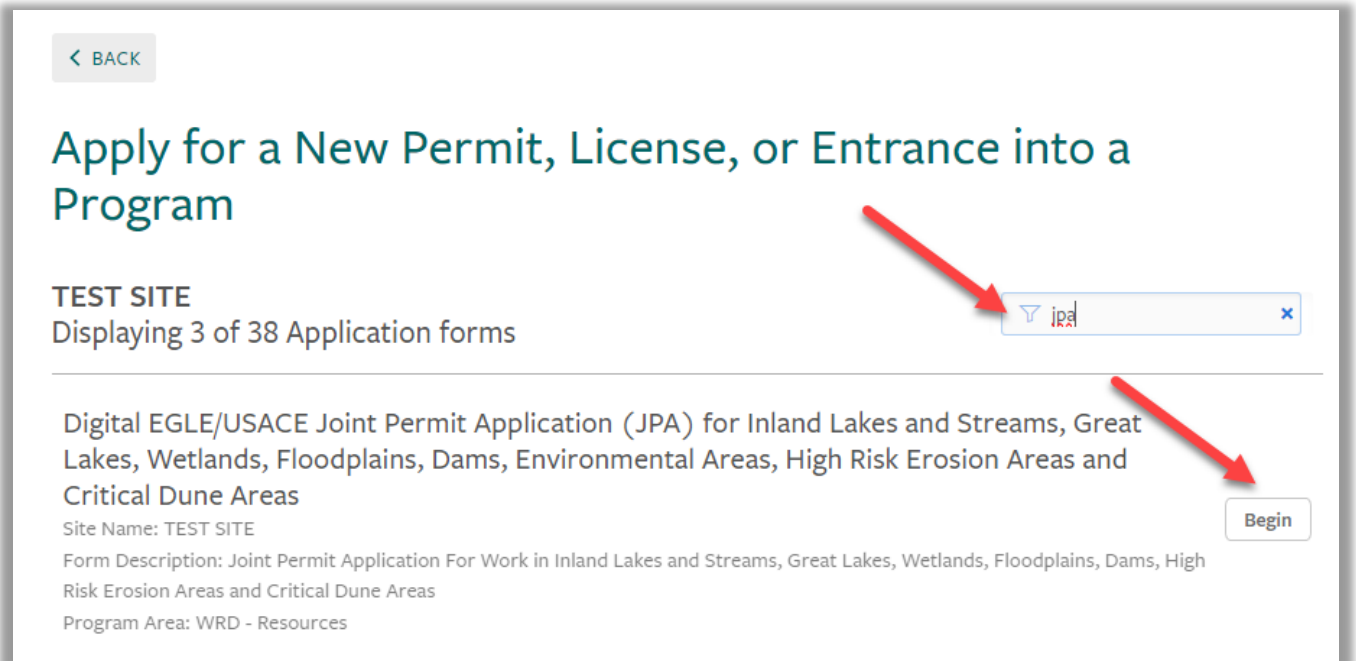
To start a new Joint Permit Application (JPA) submission you will need to create a MiEnviro Portal account at [MiEnviro.michigan.gov/ncore/external/home](https://MiEnviro.michigan.gov/ncore/external/home).




Click “Start a New Form,” the “I want to start a new application.”




Type “JPA” in the filter. Click on the “Begin” button for “Digital EGLE/USACE Joint Permit Application (JPA) for Inland Lakes and Streams, Great Lakes, Wetlands, Floodplains, Dams, Environmental Areas, High Risk Erosion Areas and Critical Dune Areas.”



Enter a site name (for example, street name of the project). Click “Continue.”



From here, read the instructions for completing the application form. Click “**Begin Form Entry**” to start the Joint Permit Application.



Fill in the required fields with detailed information pertaining to your potential project. Be sure to scroll to the bottom to certify and submit the form.
