

# DICKINSON COUNTY GUIDE

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## ARCHIVES OF MICHIGAN



Dickinson County was officially organized in 1891. The county coordinates are Ranges 27 North through 30 West (27W-30W) and Townships 39 North through 44 North (39N-44N). Adjacent counties include Marquette (north & east), Menominee (east & southeast), Marinette [WI] (south), Florence [WI] (southwest), and Iron (west). Wisconsin is on the south border of Dickinson County.

Original records from Dickinson County are available at the Archives of Michigan. The list below is organized by record type; each record type lists specific records, the years of coverage and the record group (RG) number assigned to that collection. A more detailed list of each collection can be found in finding aids at the archives.

Some of the collections below are housed at the Central Upper Peninsula and Northern Michigan University Archives in Marquette - these are indicated with a \* after the RG number.
