Charity Game Tickets (Secondary Game of Chance)

BACKGROUND

Charity Game Rule 615 states: "Secondary games of chance approved in writing by the bureau may be conducted with charity game tickets." All secondary games of chance conducted with winning charity game tickets in the following manner are approved.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The organization must post the following during the licensed gaming event at the location listed on the license:
 - a. Day of the week and time of the drawing.
 - b. Which games are included in the drawing.
 - c. Which winning tickets are included in the drawing.
 - d. The time period the winner has to claim their prize. This period can be no less than 14 days from the date the winning ticket was drawn.
2. Players may choose to enter the secondary game of chance drawing in lieu of redeeming a winning ticket.
3. Players must write their name and telephone number on the ticket and place the ticket in the designated receptacle.
4. All drawings must be conducted within the times and at the location listed on the license.
5. The player indicated on the ticket drawn shall receive the total value of all tickets entered into the secondary game of chance drawing.
6. If no name is on the ticket drawn, a new ticket must be drawn.
7. The winner's name, drawing date, and amount won must be posted at the location listed on the license for the duration of the claim period.
