MI School Data User Migration: Action Needed by June 30

MI School Data secure users will need a <u>third party MILogin account</u> to access secure data when the new site is launched this summer. Users who do not already have this type of MILogin account must create one with the same email address as their original account prior to the migration to ensure continuous access to secure data. If this is not done **by June 30**, users will need to fill out a security form and request a new account after the new MI School Data site is launched. Please refer to the <u>MILogin/MI School Data</u> <u>Instructions</u> for information on how to set up your MILogin account now to ensure continued access to your data.

New Report

• A new report on MI School Data, the <u>School-Level Expenditure</u> <u>Report</u>, breaks down expenditures of federal, state and local funds for public schools starting with 2018-19 data. Built in collaboration with MDE, this is the first report on MI School Data to show expenditures at the school level. This report fulfils reporting requirements found in the Every Student Succeeds Act. Users can compare expenditures at the county, city, ISD, district or school levels with multiple visual tools. This report will be previewed to the districts for two weeks before becoming available to the public.

Recently Released to the Public

- The <u>Parent Dashboard</u>, <u>Our Schools at a Glance</u> and the <u>Annual</u> <u>Education Report</u> have been updated to reflect school contact information captured in the EEM on April 10.
- School Services and Offerings on the <u>Parent Dashboard</u>, which shows information on schools' select programs and services (collected from districts in the MSDS and the Points of Pride section of the EEM) have been updated to reflect data captured as of April 10.

Recently Released in Preview

 The number and percent of 3rd and 11th grade students who were proficient on the M-STEP and SAT and were identified as "Section 31a At Risk" have been updated with 2018-19 data in the <u>At Risk Student</u> report. Eighth grade Math PSAT data are now included in this report. Data will be publicly available in two weeks.

Recently Released to Secure Users

 School year 2018-19 data have been added to the <u>Student Pathways</u> report for users with secure logins. This report shows student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credit, program and award information, and GPAs from in-state and out-ofstate colleges and universities.
