**POLICY 0250 Security**

The Michigan State Police will:

- Provide polygraph examinations to Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branch Departments and Sub-units on matters involving criminal issues (Biometric and Identification Division).
- On request, as staffing allows, provide security officers at all Executive, Legislative and Judicial Branch Departments and Sub-units public meetings and hearings and at state auctions conducted in the City of Lansing, Ingham, Eaton, and Clinton Counties.
