Winter Adaptation Walk

Saturdays, Mar. 8, and Sunday, Mar 16, 1 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. Starting at the Ludington State Park Amphitheater

Discover how human life is shaped by what we have learned from the natural world around us. This guided program will take you past some of the most beautiful State Park scenery, through woods and snow-covered sand dunes. The trail is roughly a mile and a half and will go up and down light hills through the forest.

Signs of Spring at Ludington State Park Walk

Saturday, Apr. 12, 1 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. Starting at the Ludington State Park Amphitheater

Observe the first signs of spring at Ludington State Park.

Discover how plants and animals prepare for the transition from cold winter to sunny summer through budding trees, emerging plants, and the return of migrating birds. The walk covers about a mile and a half, with easy terrain and views of the park's diverse landscape.
