Tahquamenon Falls State Park

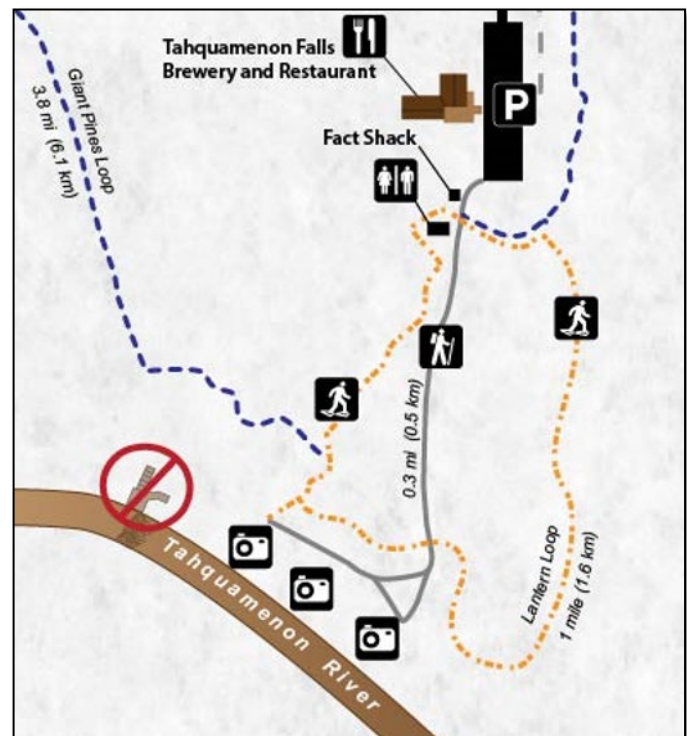
Every Saturday in February

Lantern-Lit Snowshoe Hikes: 6 – 8 p.m.

Enjoy snowshoeing our 1-mile trail lit by kerosene lanterns! Warm up with complimentary refreshments by the bonfire between laps.

Guided Snowshoe Hikes: 2 – 3 p.m.

Join a park ranger on our 1-mile snowshoe trail and learn about the park from a wintertime perspective! Meet at the Fact Shack.

- Snowshoes available to borrow on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Well-behaved dogs welcome on a leash.
- Cross country skiers welcome, but no track will be set.
