2021 Michigan Energy Code (Commercial)

The <u>Construction Code - Part 10a</u>. <u>Energy Code</u> rules were filed with the Secretary of State on December 23, 2024, and will become effective on April 22, 2025. The rules adopt by reference the 2021 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC), with amendments, deletions, and additions deemed appropriate for use in Michigan.

The bureau will notify the public when each code's electronic and hard copy versions are available for purchase and update the code book information on our website, which links to ICC for purchase. Below are some important changes that have been made to the code.

- The printing of a stand-alone commercial energy code.
- The rules allow the use of either the ASHRAE 90.1 or the Michigan amended version of the 2021 IECC.
