Last year, rule amendments required minor revisions to many regulations in chapters 3 and 4. Staff has now reviewed remaining regulations in those chapters, for which similar updating is recommended. In addition to individual versions in legislative format, a single attachment also includes clean versions of all circulated regulations.

Most of the proposed changes are merely stylistic changes to make the regulations more concise by removing unnecessary or redundant references or provisions. These changes also adopt a consistent style with other recently reviewed regulations. Several changes update or remove the names of forms and processes that have been reengineered over the past decades in process changes and improvements adopted by the Office of Classifications, Selections, and Compensation. These include discontinuing MCSCadministered applicant pools, ending the use of paper forms for classification actions, ending classification-specific employment sanctions, and clarifying that workers typically cannot be reclassified to a lead worker.
