SUBJECT: 2023 Special Populations Conference Registration Announcement

Registration for the 2023 Special Populations Conference of the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) will open on August 1, 2023. The registration link will be posted on the Office of Educational Supports website under Current Topics. The theme of this year's conference is Recognizing Greatness, which honors the diverse strengths reflected in all of Michigan's children and educators.

The conference supports <u>Michigan's Top 10 Strategic Education Plan</u> by providing professional learning, technical assistance, and opportunities for collaboration and networking to support the school, district, and intermediate school district staff in designing, implementing, and evaluating programming and services that best meet the unique needs of Michigan's special populations.

The main conference will be held in-person at the Kellogg Conference Center in East Lansing, MI, on October 25-26, 2023. A limited number of recorded sessions will also be available virtually after the conference; however, post-event recordings will not include keynote sessions. Session availability will be found within the Sched platform. In-person registration tickets will include full access to all the virtual content.

Two pre-conference sessions will be offered: one focused on English learners and the other focused on students experiencing homelessness. Both pre-conference sessions will be offered in addition to the conference and require a separate registration ticket. Pre-conference sessions will be offered in-person only due to the content and activities.
