### Michigan Department of Health and Human Services Behavioral and Physical Health and Aging Services Administration

#### State Plan Amendment Request to Update Incontinence Contract and Gloves Rates

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) plans to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) request to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to obtain authority to continue the rates increased under the Disaster Relief SPA 23-0012 specific to the Incontinence Volume Purchase Contract (for the life of the current contract) and to non-sterile gloves.

The anticipated effective date for the Incontinence Volume Purchase Contract and non-sterile gloves rate update SPA is October 1, 2024.

Global Market costs have steadily increased post-COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE), impacting the ability of the volume purchase contractor and medical supply providers to secure these products at pre-PHE Medicaid reimbursement rates.

The estimated gross cost to the State of Michigan for the SPA is \$1.8 million per year.
