

Pedestrian and Bicycle Facility Minimum Standards



The standards for off-road trails include a minimum 10-foot width with a minimum of a 2-foot clear zone on each side. The standards for bridges or boardwalks include a minimum 14-foot width between rub rails. In addition, bridges and boardwalks should meet a minimum H-10 design load rating. For roadways with no curb and gutter, the standards for on-road paved shoulders include a minimum 4-foot width facility on each side of the road. If parking is permitted, the standards for bike lanes include a minimum width of 5 feet.
