Antrim County was first organized as Megesee County in 1840 and later changed to Antrim in 1843. The county coordinates are Ranges 5 West through 9 West (5W-9W) and Townships 29 North through 32 North (29N-32N). Adjacent counties include Charlevoix (north), Otsego (east), Crawford (southeast), Kalkaska (south), Grand Traverse (southwest), and Leelanau (west). Lake Michigan, more specifically the Grand Traverse Bay, is on the western border of Antrim County.

The list below is organized by record type; each record type lists specific records, the years of coverage and the record group (RG) number assigned to that collection.
