Shiawassee County was organized in 1837. The county coordinates are Range 1 East through 4 East (1E-4E) and Township 5 North through 8 North (5N-8N). Adjacent counties include Saginaw (north), Genesee (east), Livingston (southeast), Ingham (southwest), Clinton (west), and Gratiot (northwest).
