## FY 24 2<sup>nd</sup> QUARTER ACTIVITIES

- Commissioners Elaine Andrade, Donna Callaghan, and Marcus Muldoon were selected to join the Commission to replace the Commissioners who resigned.
- Hired a new Voting Rights Act counsel to replace the one who resigned.
- Spent a considerable amount of time mapping and listening to public comments to address the Court's ruling in the *Agee*, et al v. Benson, et al in the United States District Court Western District of Michigan.
- Voted the Motown Sound FC E1 as the State House Remedial Plan and obtained approval from the United States District Court Western District of Michigan for the 2024 Election.
- Revised the Code of Conduct, Conflict of Interest Policy, and Rules of Procedures.
- Submitted a FY 24 Budget Supplemental Request (Feb. 23, 2024) to the Michigan Legislature for an additional appropriation of \$3,331,200.00 due to a significant increase in litigation expenses in the *Agee, et al v. Benson, et al* case.
