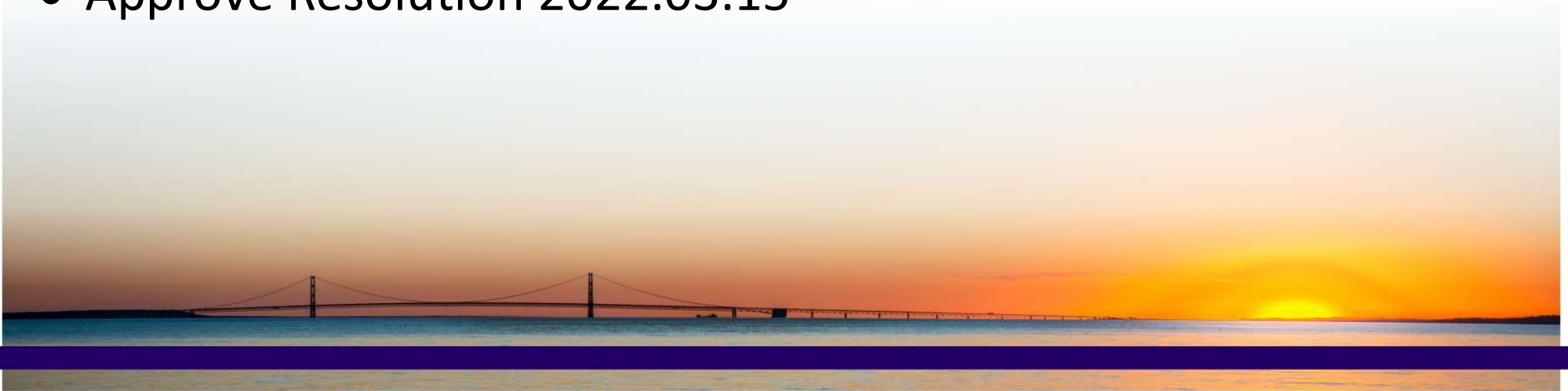
Once the requestor obtains their public record. The MICRC’s Public Records Coordinator will facilitate posting that public record to be accessible freely to the public from the MICRC’s website

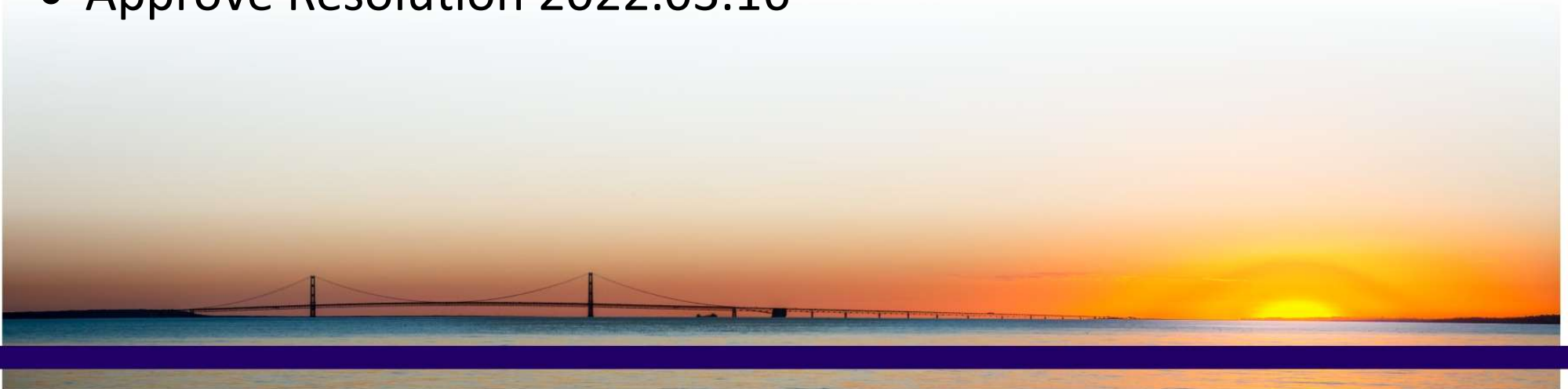
Section 5.4: Cancellation of Meetings. The Commission may cancel a meeting or public hearing by majority vote of the Commission during a meeting or by the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, or the Executive Director. If any meeting or public hearing of the Commission must be cancelled, a notice of cancellation shall be posted on the Commission website.

# CONSTITUTION



“The commission shall have legal standing to prosecute an action regarding the adequacy of resources provided for the operation of the commission, and to defend any action regarding an adopted plan. The commission shall inform the legislature if the commission determines that funds or other resources provided for operation of the commission are not adequate. The legislature shall provide adequate funding to allow the commission to defend any action regarding an adopted plan.”

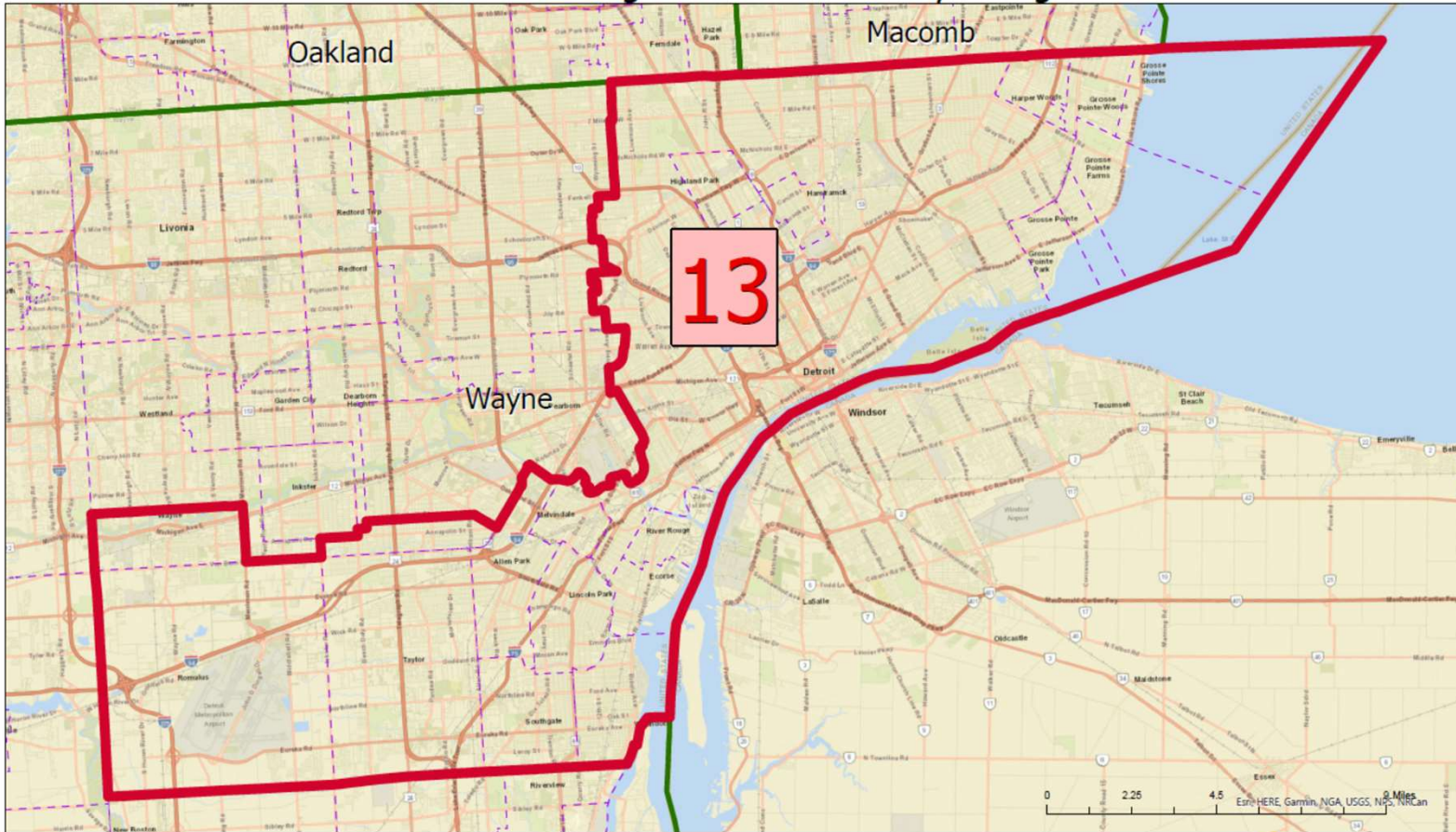
