- Discussed Dormancy. Updated on Commission Report. Based on the budget presentation, the Commission approved sending a letter to the House Appropriations Submcommittee to request additional funds for legal expenses.
- Presentation on Dormancy Report from General Counsel. Commission had an attendace report of 93 percent.
