FY 2023 BUDGET SCENARIOS



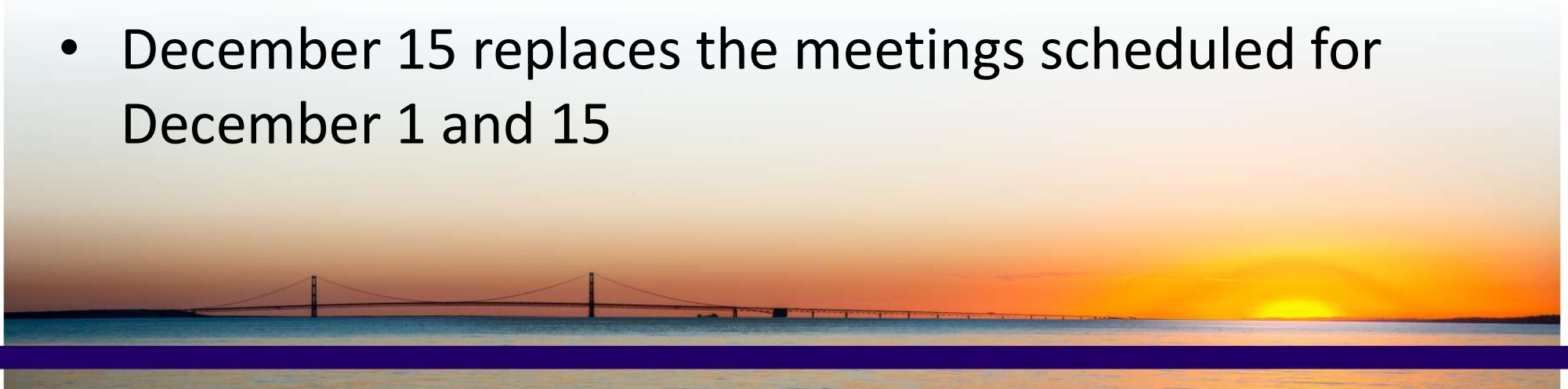
- Need to request a budget supplemental for FY 23
- Three options for Commission consideration
 - Proposal: Reduces the Commission salary to 25 percent
 - Option A: Keeps the Commission salary at 35 percent
 - Option 1: Reduces the Commission salary to a per meeting basis with required attendance at \$1350.80 per commissioner.



REVISED MEETING DATES
