I am pleased to share with you what MI Student Aid, within the Office of Higher Education in the Michigan Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential (MiLEAP), has accomplished during Fiscal Year 2023. Contained herein is the MI Student Aid Annual Report, which provides information about funds administered and the number of Michigan students awarded at each institution.

MI Student Aid's goal is to support financial equity and postsecondary accessibility by providing exceptional personalized customer service and supports through our outreach resources, making college affordable and attainable for all students. We foster data-driven organizational excellence in the administration of State financial aid programs, and work with participating institutions to identify students eligible for State financial aid to maximize utilization. We also work closely with high school counselors to encourage students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and learn more about State financial aid programs with an emphasis on Tuition Incentive Program (TIP) and our most recently initiated program for the 2023-24 academic year, the Michigan Achievement Scholarship.

The MiSSG data management system allows access to students, counselors, and financial aid administrators. Students can set up a portal account to view their award information in real-time. Counselors can easily identify which of their students need to file a FAFSA or view student eligibility for aid programs. Colleges can view student eligibility for various aid programs and certify enrollment directly using MiSSG.

During academic year 2022-23, MI Student Aid assisted **61,310* students** with more than **\$164 million*** in aid. These numbers do not include totals for Michigan Reconnect and Futures for Frontliners, two programs co-administered with Sixty by 30 in the Office of Higher Education within MiLEAP, or totals for Michigan Achievement Scholarship or MI GEAR UP, two programs that were not administered in academic year 2022-23 because they are available for 2023 graduates and onward.
