HMIS Exit Destination Guidance for Shelter Diversion

I have taken the most utilized Reasons for Leaving and paired them with the appropriate Exit Destinations.

Unknown/Disappeared – Even if your last interaction indicated some sort of +/- destination or living arrangement, if the data was not collected upon exit of the project or an exit interview was not completed, we cannot make assumptions that the last known destination is the same location the client went back to.

- Rental by client, with ongoing housing subsidy (HUD)
- Staying or living with family, permanent tenure (HUD)
- Staying or living with family, temporary tenure (e.g., room, apartment, or house) (HUD) *
- Residential project or halfway house with no homeless criteria (HUD)
- Staying or living with friends, temporary tenure (e.g., room, apartment, or house) (HUD) *
- Staying or living with friends, permanent tenure (HUD)
- SUD or Detox Facility (when assisted by SD) *
- Safe Haven

Needs Could Not Be Met

- Jail, prison, or juvenile detention facility (HUD)
- Emergency shelter, including hotel or motel paid for with emergency shelter voucher, Host Home shelter (HUD)
- Client prefers not to answer (HUD)
- Place not meant for habitation (e.g., a vehicle, an abandoned building, bus/train/subway station/airport or anywhere outside) (HUD)
