Mary Carmen Muñoz is the Executive Director of LA SED (Latin Americans for Social and Economic Development), a nonprofit organization supporting the Hispanic community in Southwest Detroit since 1969. She has a deep commitment to improving social and economic opportunities for residents. Early in her career, she co-founded Muñoz Machine Products, a company that created jobs for local Hispanics, before selling it in 1998. Later, she served as assistant director of the Michigan Minority Business Development Council. At LA SED, she oversees programs such as citizenship classes, ESL courses, youth mentorship, and senior services. Her leadership has driven key initiatives like the "Road to Restoration" clinics, which help residents regain their driver's licenses.
