It was moved by Morris, supported by Nolde, and unanimously approved to adopt the minutes of April 4, 2023. (Item 1 on agenda)

It was moved by Morris, supported by Nolde, and unanimously approved the 2023 Preliminary Equalization Valuations for each separately equalized classification of property in each of the 83 Michigan counties.
